# CROSO Board Position Posting 

Volunteer Position: CROSO Board Member
Term of Service: 3 years, renewable
Accountable To: CROSO Board President and CROSO Executive Director
CROSO's Mission: CROSO is dedicated to making possible the transformation of Ugandan communities by providing comprehensive post-secondary education scholarships to former street children.

## Expectations:

1. Participate in all 5 annual CROSO board meetings.
a. Pre-COVID, board meetings were held in the Chicago area and members were expected to participate in person or via phone/Zoom. Since March 2020, all board meetings have been conducted on Zoom and everyone participates virtually now.
b. We understand that emergencies happen and important family functions (weddings, etc.) get scheduled without checking everyone's calendars.
c. However, if more than one meeting is missed in a calendar year, that board member will be removed from the board for the following year.
2. Actively participate on at least one committee, and no more than two committees.
a. Participate in at least $75 \%$ of those meetings. (These typically occur via phone/video call.)
b. If the board member cannot be present for the committee meeting, a conversation with the chair of that committee will need to be scheduled for it to count as participation.
3. Connect new people to CROSO.
a. Contribute new names to our email and mailing lists.
b. Act as an ambassador for CROSO in the community. Share with others that you are involved in this work. (This can include friends, family, colleagues, announcements to your alumni chapters, etc.)
c. When opportunities arise, help network on behalf of CROSO.
4. Make a substantial financial contribution to CROSO.
a. In the past, we asked board members to fill at least one table at the annual benefit which was held in Chicago each fall. It was about $\$ 800-\$ 1,000$ per table and helped achieve the goal of supporting CROSO and bringing new supporters to CROSO.
b. This expectation can also be achieved by supporting CROSO's virtual events (CROSO has an annual online day of giving in April, and will continue to host online events throughout the year), or by hosting a separate event in your area, etc.
c. In the current climate, in-person event planning is still up in the air. That said, it is a fundamental component of board membership to both raise funds for CROSO and bring new potential donors to CROSO, so we are asking our board members to be creative.
